

Wisconsin Citizen-based Monitoring Awards 2020 Call for Nominations

Do you know a person or group that is making a difference in citizen-based monitoring in Wisconsin? Nominate them for a Citizen-based Monitoring Award! All nominees should be members of the citizen-based monitoring community who go above and beyond to monitor Wisconsin's natural resources. Volunteers, educators, researchers, land managers, and others involved in citizen-based monitoring are all eligible. <u>Nominations</u> Due February 16.

Awards

Citizen-based Monitoring Program of the Year

Eligibility: Any citizen-based monitoring project, group, or organization that has been active in 2018 or 2019 is eligible.

Outstanding Achievement in Citizen-based Monitoring

Eligibility: Any adult (18 or over) who has participated in citizen-based monitoring in Wisconsin in 2018 or 2019 is eligible.

Outstanding Achievement in Youth Citizen-based Monitoring

Eligibility: Any youth (17 or younger) who has participated in citizen-based monitoring in Wisconsin in 2018 or 2019 is eligible. Nominees may be over 18 if they were 17 or younger during at least part of 2018 or 2019.

David N. Redell Award for Lifetime Achievement in Citizen-based Monitoring

Eligibility: Any individual who has participated long-term in citizen-based monitoring in Wisconsin and who has gone above and beyond to made unique, extraordinary contributions to the Wisconsin citizen-based monitoring community. Accomplishments could include:

- created or revolutionized a monitoring project or group
- been a successful ambassador for citizen-based monitoring, increasing the long-term quality and quality of participation by providing impactful education and outreach throughout the state or in a region of the state
- made long-term, extraordinary contributions to one or more projects, such as being responsible for most of the data collected in a geographic area or on a certain group of species.
