Woolly Milkweed (<u>Asclepias</u> <u>lanuginosa</u>) Habitat: Dry, dry-mesic, and sand prairies; barrens Best ID Time: Late May - late June

Dwarf Milkweed (<u>Asclepias</u> <u>ovalifolia</u>) Habitat: Barrens and sand prairies, including the disturbed edges, such as roadsides. Best ID Time: June





Purple Milkweed (Asclepias

<u>purpurascens</u>)

Habitat: A broad range, from wetmesic prairies to oak woodlands Best ID Time: Late June - late July

Prairie Milkweed (<u>Asclepias</u> <u>sullivantii</u>) Habitat: Mesic and wet-mesic prairies Best ID Time: Early June - early July
